





Instructions for attaching the toll box

- The box is already activated and ready for immediate use.
- Clean the intended area on the windscreen.
- Remove the protective film from the adhesive strip on the holder.
- Attach the holder including toll box to the inside of the windscreen next to the rear-view mirror, as shown in the diagram:





In motorhomes with alcove, we recommend mounting it centrally approx.
 15 cm above the dashboard on the windscreen.

ATTENTION!

The correct mounting position is crucial for the function of the box!

Please refer to the vehicle manual, the vehicle manufacturer or your garage to find out about any metallised coatings of your vehicle's windscreen and eventual cutouts of these coatings.

Usually, there is an area next to the rear-view mirror which is big enough for the toll box and marked by dots/shading. The toll box should be attached inside of this area as it represents the coating's cutout and is specifically intended for toll boxes.

The toll box does not need to have visual contact with the toll station, but makes 'radio contact' with the toll station. This radio 'contact' can be disturbed or completely prevented by a metallised coating, which is why correct installation is important.

Note:

- > The toll box must not be labelled, painted or similar Stickers must not be removed
- Loss or theft of the toll box and changes of the license plate number must be reported to maut1 immediately.
- If the vehicle is towed after a breakdown, the device must be removed from the vehicle and wrapped in a metallic shield.
- Shipping or transport from abroad may only take place if the toll box is protected by aluminium foil (e.g. in case of foreign shipments often see maut1-packaging) in order to avoid unwanted transactions.



Which lanes can I use with the toll box?





Italy

You can use your box on these lanes in Italy (currently without Sicily and ferry Messina-Villa San Giovanni and without the use of our toll box for parking).



France

You can use your box in France on these lanes. Car parks marked with this symbol included.





Spain

You can use your box in Spain on these lanes (currently without AP-1). Car parks marked with this symbol included.





Portugal

You can use your box on these lanes in Portugal. Car parks marked with this symbol included.

△ The toll box' signal sounds are irrelevant in the countries listed above.

What do I do if my toll box does not work?

- Please make sure that the box is attached inside of an area without a
 metallised coating (A metallized coating is not usually visible. However,
 if there is an area marked by dots/shading, usually, the toll box must be
 attached inside of this area, as it usually represents the coating's cutout and
 is the only area the radio signal is not interfered by.)
- **Starting 50 m** in front of the next toll station, please hold the toll box out of the side window up until you have reached the barrier. By doing so you can test whether your windscreen is interfering with the signal and preventing communication between toll box and toll station. (Only holding the device out of the window right at the barrier has no effect).
- If your toll box still does not work, you can scan the toll box' barcode at the toll station, contact the staff (using the emergency button), take a ticket or pay on site. (Please keep all tickets and receipts).
